3. Atlantics

- Labour Day weekend – September 2/3
- Combined with **Mini-Palma** – September 4
- Discussion held on having 3 relays
 - Requires changing course of fire
 - Suggested dropping 300m distances from BN/HC/LS
 - NS will prepare a tentative schedule for other provinces to review
- Discussion held on squadding
 - Suggested staying on same relay for morning & switching for afternoon
 - Randomize squadding within relay as much as possible
 - Two shooters/target as much as possible (3 shooters if necessary)

4. Mini-Palma

- Traditionally the 3rd weekend in September; scheduled for **September 4**
- Combined with Atlantics – September 2/3
- Evangeline elected Captain
- Team selection to be based on Atlantics results
- Discussion held on running concurrent event on Sept. 4 for anyone who does not make the team
- Discussion held on team composition: suggested discussing with New England Team changing requirements from (6 TR + 4 F-Class) to a minimum of 4 competitors from each class

8. Discussions

1. Scoring

- Electronic scoring showing Left/Middle/Right shooter is useful for catching crossfires & other accidental errors

2. Match Committee Role

- Match Committee should meet after a protest has been made
- Match Director & Stats should be responsible for scoring issues
- (Chief) Range Office should be responsible for any safety issues

3. DCRA

- Nationals
 - 2022 Attendance (TR) – 90 competitors, 15 lanes
 - Estimated 2023 Attendance (TR) – 120-140 competitors; (F-Class) 40-60 competitors
 - Hoping to hold in Ottawa, but Connaught Range is scheduled for range work during July
 - Option B – CFB Borden (Toronto); 1000y
 - Option C – Quebec City; 600y (but difficult range due to wind)
 - It was noted that the 2021 F-Class Nationals were cancelled due to template issues and the F-Class template has not yet been approved for the above-mentioned ranges
 - Discussed holding F-Class Nationals at a different range than TR Nationals
- Discussed current state of McDonald-Stewart Pavilion (Bisley, UK)
